- 13) Request of the Port of New Orleans to exempt from the classified service 15 positions, in accordance with State Civil Service Rule 4.1(d)2, effective February 1, 2017 through January 31, 2021.  - Announced the reappointment of Commissioner Hughes and Commissioner Griffin to the State Civil Service Commission; Reminded the Commission that the Governor has until February 12, 2017 to announce the appointment to the Commission for the Second Congressional District.
 - Announced the resignation of Commissioner Dellafosse from the State Civil Service Commission as she has a business opportunity that would be in conflict with serving on the Board. Director Decoteau reminded the Commission that Dillard University has until February 11, 2017 to submit three nominees to the Governor for this unexpired term representing the Third Congressional District.
 - o Provided the Commission with an Legislative updates
 - o Informed the Commission that the Legislature will hold a Special Session beginning February 13, 2017 through February 23, 2017.
 - Announced the ballots for the Employee Representative Civil Service Commissioner election were mailed out yesterday, January 31, 2017, and voting ends on February 23, 2017. The three candidates on the ballot are:
 - Ronald Broussard from the Department of Transportation and Development
 - Kristy Folse from the Department of Transportation and Development
 - C. Pete Fremin from the Department of Public Safety and Corrections
 - Reminded HR Community that February 8, 2017 is the deadline for agencies to submit items for the March 1, 2017 Civil Service Commission meeting.
