THE STATE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION CONVENED ITS MONTHLY GENERAL BUSINESS MEETING AT 9:11 A.M. ON WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 4, 2017. PRESENT WERE CHAIRMAN DAVID DUPLANTIER, VICE-CHAIRMAN D. - Request of the <u>New Orleans City Park for authority under the provisions of State Civil Service</u> <u>Rule 4.1(d)1, to allow all incumbents appointed to a position approved under 4.1(d)1, to work over</u> <u>the 1245 hour restriction, effective October 7, 2017.</u> (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) THE COMMISSION GRANTED THE REQUEST AS RECOMMENDED, TO ALLOW ALL INCUMBENTS APPOINTED TO A 4.1(d)1 PARK ATTENDANT POSITION AT NEW ORLEANS CITY PARK, TO WORK UP TO 2080 HOURS IN A 12-MONTH APPOINTMENT PERIOD, EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 7, 2017 THROUGH OCTOBER 6, 2019.
