THE STATE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION CONVENED ITS MONTHLY GENERAL BUSINESS MEETING AT 9:10 A.M. ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, 2018. PRESENT WERE CHAIRMAN DAVID DUPLANTIER, VICE-CHAIRMAN D. SCOTT HUGHES, COMMISSIONERS JOHN MCLURE, G. LEE GRIFFIN, C. PETE FREMIN, RONALD CARRERE AND JO ANN NIXON.
