The State Civil Service Commission convened its monthly general business meeting at 9:21 a.m. on Wednesday, October 2, 2019. Present were Chairman David Duplantier, Vice Chairman D. Scott Hughes, Commissioners Ronald Carrere, Jr., C. Pete Fremin, G. Lee Griffin, John McLure and Jo Ann Nixon.

Opportunity for Public Comment (No Attachment)
 Gail Wallace requested to address the State Civil Service Commission to hear her appeal in accordance with State Civil Service Rule 13.10(a), 13.10(c), and 2.9(f). State Civil Service General Counsel Sherri Gregoire explained that Ms. Wallace has exhausted all remedies and no relief is available. The Commission declined to take up the matter.

On motion duly made, seconded, and passed; the Commission took the specified action as listed for each of the requests listed below:

- 1) Consideration of the Minutes of the Commission meeting held September 4, 2019. The Commission unanimously approved the minutes as written.
- 2) Request from the Louisiana Judicial College to appoint Michael Schachtman to serve as the Louisiana Judicial College's appointed representative on the Comprehensive Public Training Program (CPTP) Policy Board. (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission unanimously granted the request.

 <u>Rule 6.16.2, effective October 2, 2019.</u> (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission unanimously granted the request.

- 6) Request of <u>Louisiana State University and A&M College to establish a Perquisites policy in accordance with State Civil Service Rule 6.3.1, effective October 2, 2019.</u> (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission unanimously granted the request.
- 7) Request of the <u>Jefferson Parish Human Services Authority (JPHSA)</u> to amend a <u>Crisis Leave Pool Policy in accordance with State Civil Service Rule 11.34, effective October 2, 2019.</u> (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission unanimously granted the request.
- 8) Request of the <u>Port of South Louisiana to extend authority to exempt from the classified service, one (1) Airport Director position, in accordance with State Civil Service Rule 4.1(d)2, effective October 2, 2019 through October 1, 2023. (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission unanimously granted the request.</u>
- 9) Request of the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH) to compensate exempt employees performing assigned disaster-related duties at the time and one-half rate for overtime hours worked in accordance with State Civil Service Rule 21.9(d), effective July 11, 2019 through July 10, 2024. (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission unanimously granted the request.
- 10) Request of the Louisiana Department of Revenue to reappoint one (1) Classified WAE incumbent, Kaila Kelly, who exceeded 1245 hours, in accordance with State Civil Service Rule 23.6(a-b), effective October 8, 2019. (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission unanimously granted the request.
- 11) Request of the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH), Medical Vendor Administration (MVA) to establish a Special Entrance Rate policy in accordance with State Civil Service Rule 6.5(b), effective October 2, 2019. (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission unanimously granted the request.
- 12) Request of the <u>Southeast Louisiana Flood Protection Authority-East to establish a Premium Pay policy in accordance with State Civil Service Rule 6.16(a), effective October 2, 2019.</u> (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission unanimously granted the request.
- 13) Request from the <u>Department of State Civil Service to extend ongoing delegated authority to the State Civil Service Director to grant exceptions to Civil Service Rule 6.5(c), effective November 6, 2019.</u> (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission unanimously granted the request contingent upon the Commission continuing to receive quarterly reports.
- 14) Request from the <u>Department of State Civil Service to extend ongoing delegated authority to the State Civil Service Director to grant exceptions to Civil Service Rule 6.5(g)</u>.
