SUBJECT:	CPTP Continuing Education Courses for Performance Year 2019-2020

The State Civil Service Comprehensive Public Training Program (CPTP) is pleased to announce that the list of continuing education courses for Performance Year 2019-20 is now available in CPTP's catalogue on LEO, and on the SCS website <u>here</u>, by clicking "By Program". According to Civil Service Rule 25.2, all classified state supervisors are required to complete Mandatory Training Requirements, which include a continuing education component for supervisors who have completed their respective programs. As in previous years, these supervisors must complete one of the continuing education courses from the list CPTP provides between the dates of July 1, 2019 and June 30, 2020. An explanation of the requirement, as well as a listing of the courses, can also be found in the attached infographic.
