SUBJECT:	Procedures for Filling Positions Under Rule 22.2

This general circular serves as a reminder to Appointing Authorities and Human Resources Directors of Civil Service Rule 22.2. According to provisions of this rule, an appointing authority shall obtain approval from the State Civil Service Director before making a permanent appointment to any job at or above MS-524, AS-623, SS-422, PS-120, WS-223, or TS-319 between the date of any election for a statewide elected office (October 14, 2023) through Inauguration Day (January 8, 2024).

The following chart indicates the types of permanent appointments that need prior approval of the Director.

Agencies may post for jobs at or above MS-524, AS-623, SS-422, PS-120, WS-223 or TS-319. However, agencies are required to receive approval from the Director prior to making <u>any</u> <u>permanent appointments</u> to jobs at those levels.

The request process will be handled as follows:

- Appointments into positions affected by this rule shall receive approval from the Director prior to the effective date of the appointment by means of the <u>Request for SCS Director</u> <u>Approval to Fill Vacancies Prior to Election Form</u>.
- Agencies are to submit request forms to <u>Ashton Brown</u> or <u>Makayla Harris</u>.
- Agencies will be notified via email of the Director's decision.
